








# Year 1 - Turrets and Tales - Topic Home Learning

| <p><b><u>Fireworks in a Jar!</u></b></p> <div data-bbox="98 507 712 689"> <p><b>You Will Need</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A jam jar or similar</li> <li>• A small bowl or dish</li> <li>• Cooking oil</li> <li>• Different coloured food colouring</li> <li>• Fork</li> </ul>  </div> <p>This is a great experiment to try at home or at school. It only needs a few basic ingredients and everyday kitchen equipment.</p> <p><b>Method</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Fill the jar about <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> full with the warm water.</li> <li>2 Mix the oil and a few drops of food colouring together in the bowl with a fork.</li> <li>3 Pour the mixture slowly into the jar with the water.</li> <li>4 Watch as the fireworks begin!</li> </ol> | <p>Can you learn your favourite Christmas song off by heart and record yourself singing it?
