

Important Message about Homework.

This week English and Maths homework has been set for your child on IXL. IXL is an interactive learning platform that can be accessed via a computer, tablet or smartphone. You can access it either through navigating to this address <https://uk.ixl.com/signin> or by downloading the app in the appropriate app store.

You will receive your child's login via parentmail on Friday (along with their Purple Mash and Times Table Rock Stars logins).

Each week when you log in you will see that your child has been assigned work to complete. Teachers will be able to monitor progress, view work and see how long children have been using IXL. This will then allow them to provide personalised learning for your child and clearly identify the next steps needed in their progress. The expectation is that children in Year 3 should spend 20 minutes each week on the assigned English and maths activities.

Reminders:

1. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school each day
2. Please send the reading record in daily (even when it is not book change day) so that we can record any reading that we do with your child.
3. Please do not allow your child to bring in their own books, folders, pencils, pencil cases or toys. This helps us to reduce the amount of items transferring back and forth.
