This week's learning:

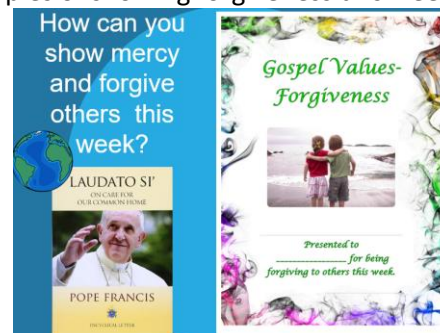
This week we have begun our topic of Twisted Tales by looking at the story of the Gingerbread Man. We have acted out the story, added actions and thought about the characters.

In maths we have looked at numbers to 100 – we have written them in numerals, in words and represented them using part-whole models and dienes.

In RE this week we have looked at the events in the Creation story and thought about Psalm 139. To follow up our lessons, you may wish to talk to your child about the dreams they think God has for them.

This week our liturgy was based around the Gospel Value of forgiveness. Please discuss this with your child and ask if they have any examples of showing forgiveness this week.

IXL Home Learning

This week English and Maths home learning has been set for your child on IXL. IXL is an interactive learning platform that can be accessed via a computer, tablet or smartphone. You can access it either through navigating to this address <https://uk.ixl.com/signin> or by downloading the app in the appropriate app store.

You will receive your child's login via parentmail on Friday (along with their Purple Mash and Times Table Rock Stars logins).

Each week when you log in you will see that your child has been assigned work to complete. Teachers will be able to monitor progress, view work and see how long children have been using IXL. This will then allow them to provide personalised learning for your child and clearly identify the next steps needed in their progress. The expectation is that children should spend 40 minutes each week on the assigned English and maths activities.

Level C - Task L10 for English (purple and green groups)

Level C - Task C1 for English (blue group)
