

Please find below some interactive, fun filled activities for you to carry out as a family.

<p><u>Our local environment</u> Please spend time with your child looking at the world around them. Go on a sensory walk as you take your trip. What can your child see, hear, smell, touch and maybe even taste. Ask them to collect natural treasures on their walk and perhaps make a collage. As part of this work, we will learn about traditions and customs and will look at the way that homes are decorated with the colours red and gold. You may like to use paper and scissors to create a Chinese New Year lantern.</p> 	<p><u>Chinese New Year</u> As part of our topic, we will be learning about the traditions and customs of Chinese New Year. <p><u>Habitats</u> Take time to look at different habitats with your child. Look at pictures of where different animals live and how they adapt to their home. Consider whether they have fur, skin or scales. Learn about what they eat and where they sleep.</p> 	<p><u>Cosmic Yoga-We're going on a Bear Hunt</u> Please work with your child on this children's yoga session that combines yoga with a story. This session is 'We're going on a bear Hunt.' Perhaps you could look at the work of Monet to create a watercolour scene, or maybe look at Lowry's work to create a townscape.
