Maths

This week we have continued to focus on counting and number recognition. We have also looked at numicon shapes and have used these to help us learn about numbers in ascending order. To help your child with ongoing number work, please carry out the following practical task.



Growing Numbers

Using lego/duplo/wooden bricks, ask your child to make towers that are 1, 2, 3 blocks tall. As they work, talk to your child about the way the towers are getting bigger. Encourage your child to continue with their 'growing' towers adding one more block each time until they reach 5 blocks or even 10. As they work, ask them to count their bricks and to talk about which tower is the 'tallest' and 'shortest' etc...


Thank you

Reading


Thank you for writing comments about your child's response to their books in the reading record book. We ask you to continue to comment in order to keep us informed of your child's response to their books.
